## Placing an MRI Inpatient Request?

Medical Imaging require a completed MRI Safety Questionnaire Form (Q Form) before they can schedule your patient.

The MRI Safety Questionnaire form can be completed by the patient if they are competent and able to do so, or a close family member who has a full detailed understanding of the patient's medical history.

Health care professionals can assist with the completion of the form with patient/family member assistance however, responsibility remains with the referring medical team to ensure the form has been completed and provided to Medical Imaging.

Additionally, if a patient has a cardiac implanted device the 'MRI Cardiac Implantable Electronic Device (CIED) Checklist' must be provided along with the 'MRI Safety Questionnaire' to the Medical Imaging staff prior to the patient receiving an appointment.

If your patient has an implantable device and you need clarification if your patient is safe for an MRI, please contact the MRI Inpatient Radiographer on 512 42016.
